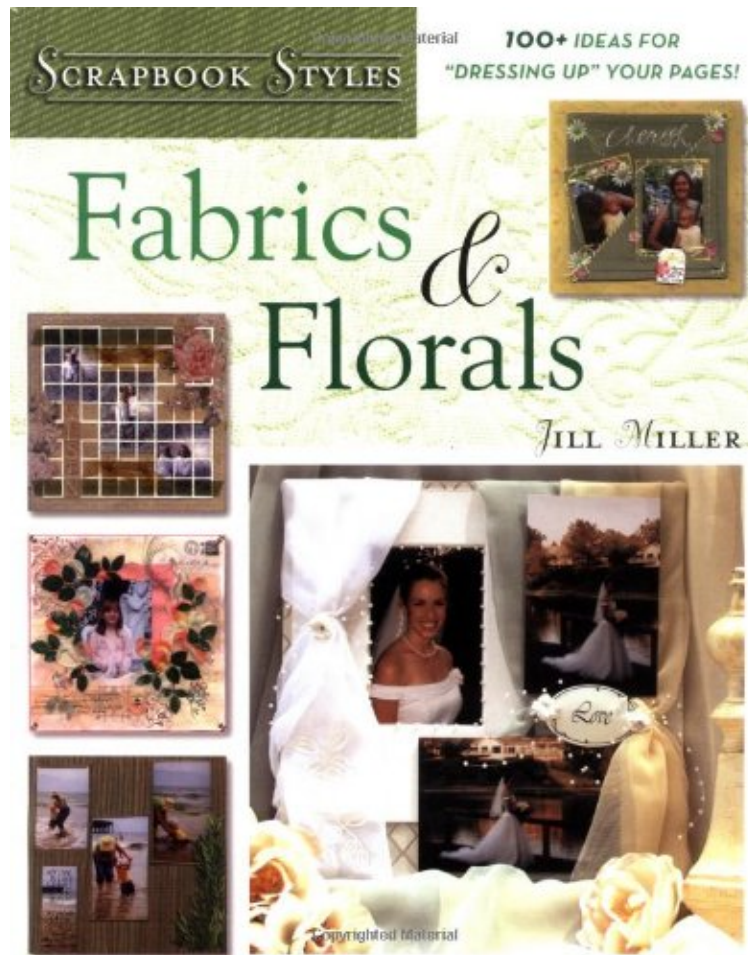

The sample pages are inspiring and quite varied.I like that it gives a number of uses that don't involve sewing so I can make a doily envelope for a page without pulling out needle and thread. There are iron-on stitch effects, and easy paper quilt patterns.There are also lots of flowery pages using silk flowers, floral fabrics and paper flowers.
