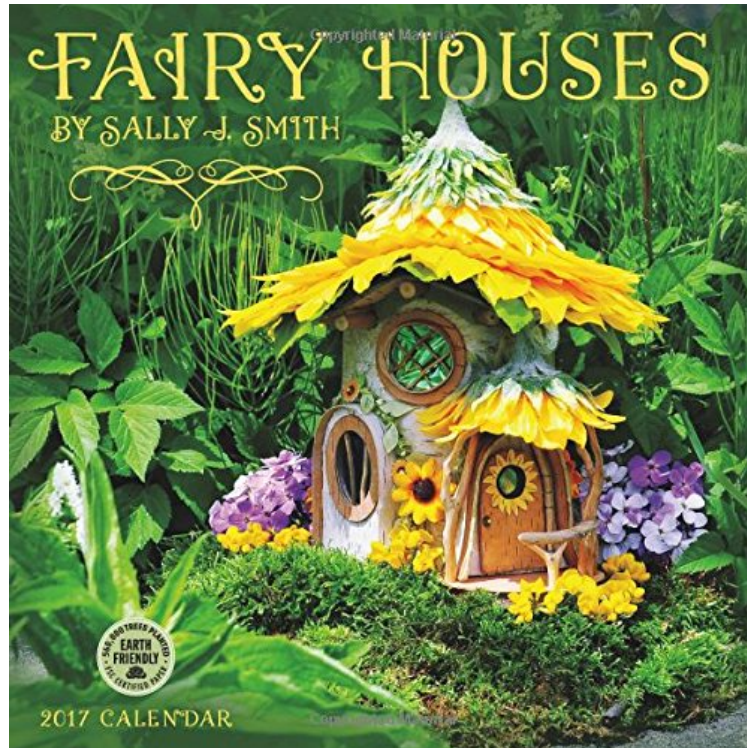

The fairy houses are amazing, the photography is great, and the calendar has a lot of information, such as holidays, phases of the moon, and when daylight saving time begins and ends. The paper is thick and sturdy. The surface is shiny, so it is difficult to write on it with anything other than a ballpoint pen.
