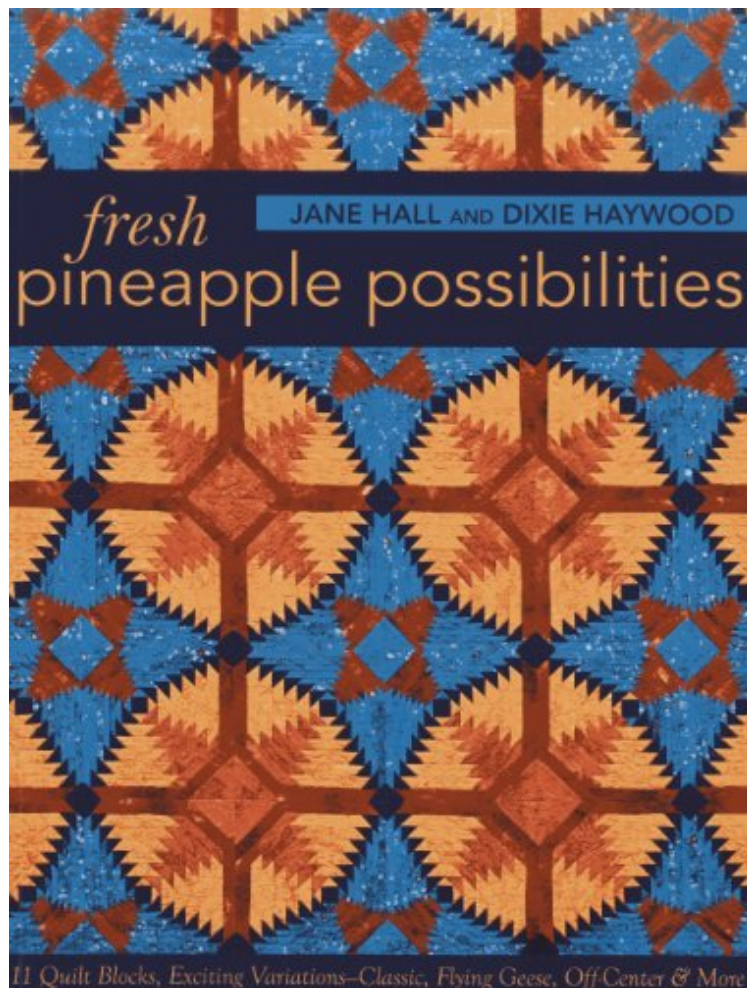

Pineapple quilts are very labor intensive but very much worth the time and trouble it takes to make them. You can check out pineapple quilt images on Pinterest to see some of the design possibilities of this very traditional quilt pattern. Quiltmakers like Freddy Moran and Gyleen Fitzgerald produce very beautiful contemporary pineapple quilts

that can inspire you in making your own creation. This book by Jane Hall and Dixie Haywood contains all of the information needed to produce and use the foundation patterns to produce accurately pieced blocks, how to manipulate the pattern to produce new designs (using off center blocks, different size logs, changing colors, etc.); how to assemble the blocks and best quilting choices. They have included some updating on the pineapple block design that I have not seen anywhere else that will offer new ideas for those interested in designing these works. The books that they have previously published are very thorough, laying the groundwork for producing quality quilts that will last a long time, and this book is no different. You can also take a class in foundation piecing from Jane Hall at the Academy of Quilting, an online quilting school that is replacing Quilt University. I took her class and highly recommend it as well as this book. You will learn a lot and will find that foundation piecing will improve your quilts enormously.
