Despite being published in the 1970's, this book has an unusually high number of color photos. I somewhat disagree with the other reviewers who appreciate the stitch diagrams. I zoom completely past those as they're in grainy bw: you can tell different colors are being blended but you're darned if you can tell what they are. No, I like the finished projects, a little surprised because so much from that decade is too "groovy" for me. The main thing is that this book can teach you to do some needlepoint and/or inspire you to design pictures for yourself. It's a nice book to browse.
