The patterns for each month's block are included, and Pat also includes extended uses [patterns, applique art, and lettering] for the substantially sized blocks to be used in alternate projects. Days after I completed the workshop, I was still thinking about her quilt, so I ordered the book through .I was concerned before I received the book that I wouldn't be able to make her quilt since her method of machine donut-hole applique and machine blanket stitch were new to me. However, NO NEED TO THINK TWICE, because Pat's directions are methodical and well organized, and she has close up pictures of important steps. I've completed January and February, and am collecting fabric for the other months; and now I have the confidence to redesign some of the blocks to make them mine!Her drawings are very fluid and liberating; one feels that there is not

Version I of the 85" x 85" quilt is made from vibrant batik fabrics for a bright and bold look. Version II uses more traditional colors and prints for a warm and toasty feel. To make either version of this quilt, you might want to organize or participate in a block of the month group through your local quilt shop or guild, or you can opt to make it on your own from start to finish. But don't stop with the quilt! Other seasonal projects include a tabletop set, a project bag, a pillow, and a throw. Some of the blocks can even be finished as mini quilts.
