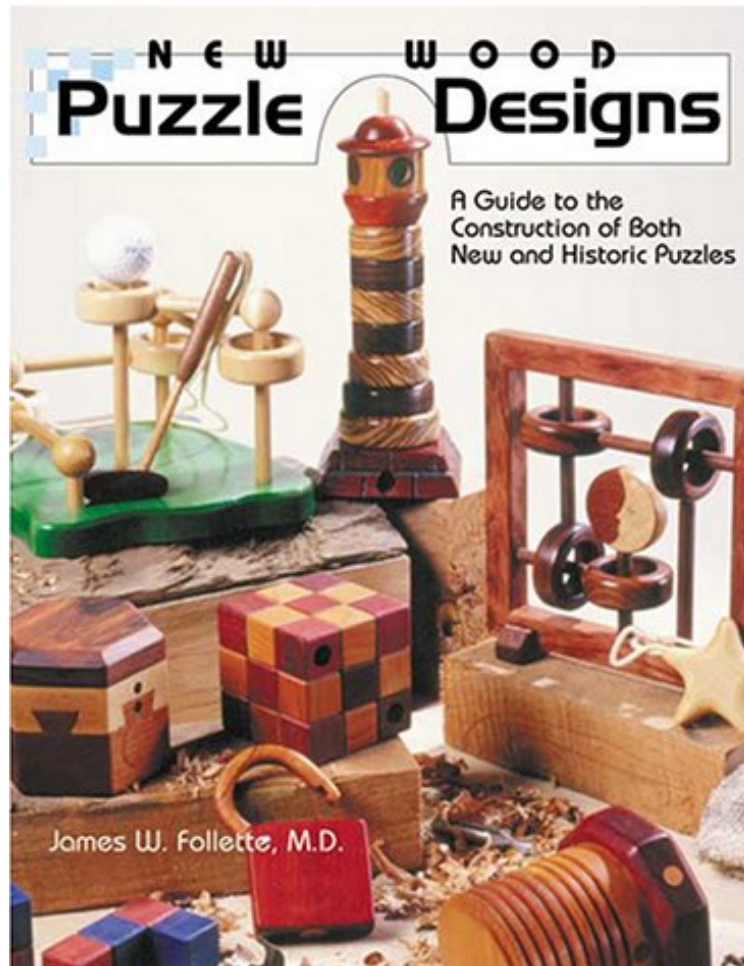

There is also expert advice on the woods, glues, and finishes that will give the best results.
