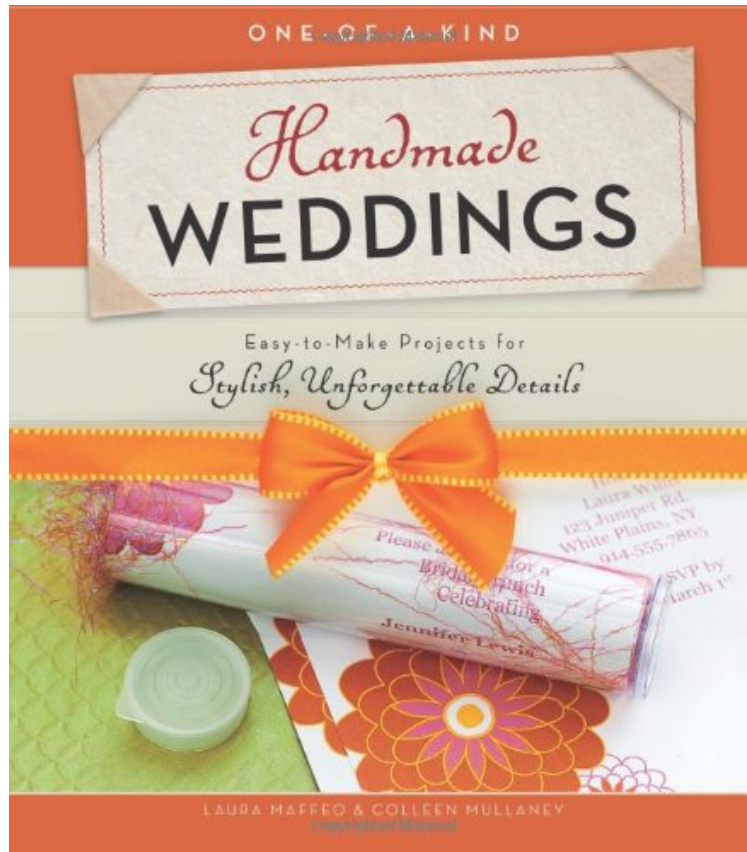

The projects were amateurish and only one or two were even vaguely "stylish". If anything, they were pedestrian, uninspired and quite basic. I have nothing against simple DIY projects, but the execution was overwhelmingly dated and dowdy, especially the chapter on artificial flowers. Truly, the flowers looked like something you would find in a two-dollar shop, even after they had been crafted into finished items. I would only recommend this book to someone seeking the very simplest of projects, or someone whose creative flair and ability to envisage a finished piece in their own choice of materials is so well developed that they won't be put off by the unstylish execution of the sample projects. "Handmade Weddings: More Than 50 Crafts to Personalize Your Big Day" offers a FAR more impressive resource for wedding DIY inspiration, while "Paperie for Inspired Living: Stationery and Decorations for Weddings, Parties, and Other Special Occasions" is much more exhaustive (and far prettier) if

you're looking for help with crafting your own invitations.
