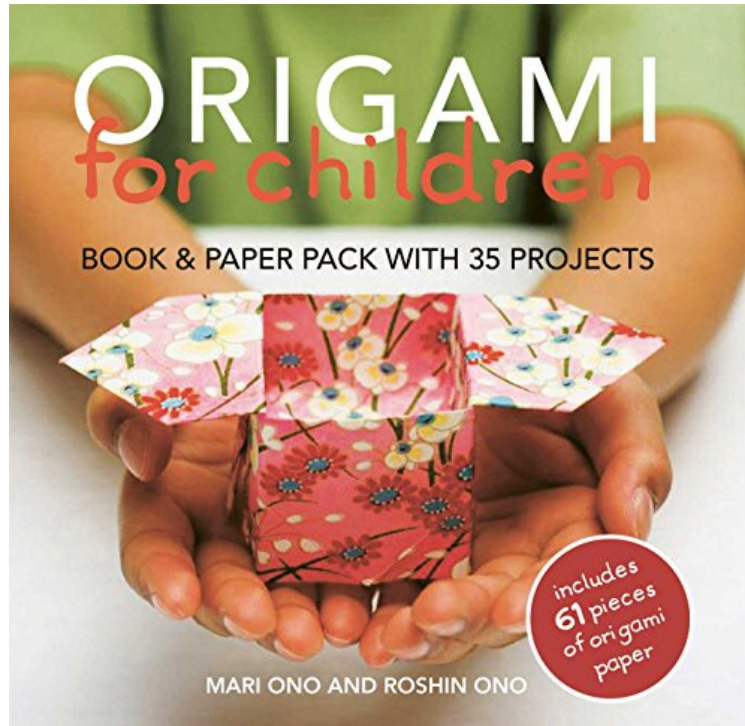

The instructions were very clear, But in the advanced ones some of the pictures of folds were a bit hard to follow and needed some adult interpretation.Some of the smaller folds were a bit difficult to follow, but the sense of achievement when they worked was great. As the youngest boy who was using it was only four I thought it was great for his dexterity, hand eye co-ordination, self esteem and sense of achievement. The simpler ones were great for him and held his attention well.
