I bought it to try and organize my genealogy stuff on my computer, but found that I couldn't export my info from other programs online or on my computer (i.e. Ancestry or Legacy) and would have to enter all the information over again. People should be aware that this is not genealogy software. It is good for its intended purpose of making family scrapbooks, but most

computers come with software which will do the same thing included. I have a Mac, and Iphoto and iMovie will organize my pictures just as well, if not better. But if you have limited computer skills or a computer without decent programs for photo editing, this might be useful to you. However, I am giving it a low rating because it is categorized as Reference/Genealogy and does not even come close to meeting the needs of the most amateur genealogist. The fact that it is not compatible with Ged com files is reason enough to recategorize this book.
