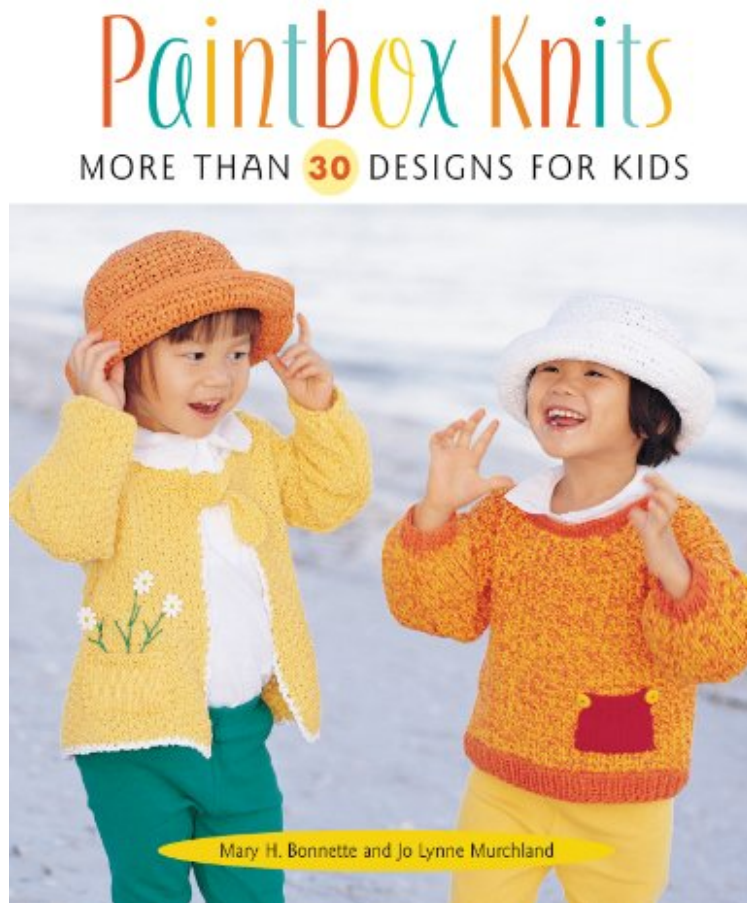

Well-known British knitwear designer Mellor provides little instruction for the beginning knitter, making this book more appropriate for those with intermediate skills. *Paintbox Knits*, on the other hand, is not only a pattern book but also a teaching tool; the authors guide the reader step by step through each pattern, including a wealth of knitting instruction along the way. If I were to count the number of designs I would love to make were time and money no consideration and divide by total number of designs, *Animal Knits* would be batting a record-setting 730 while *Paintbox Knits* is doing better than most major league hitters at 400. Another way to gauge value might be to observe that while *Animal Knits* costs 77¢ per pattern, *Paintbox Knits* costs approximately \$1 per pattern.
