Nearly every project in the book requires additional materials--everything from chenille stems to wiggly eyes to rickrack to dowel rods. Certainly, the projects are cute and kid-friendly, and the additional materials aren't anything too expensive or hard to find. We tried making the whale origami (featured on the cover), but it wasn't even close to the image of the finished project... we'll have to try that one again! But, overall, the crafts are very appropriate for 4-7 year olds. Caveat - you do need to enlarge the patterns on a copier (200%) - so unless you have access to a copier with larger sized paper, you won't be able to begin right away (my guess is that 75% of the crafts require the patterns provided).
