They require precise cutting and sometimes using a razor. Older kids that have better dexterity with cutting and folding can handle these. Little kids still enjoy watching them being put together. To make them last longer and allow other kids to do the same project, I scanned and printed out the pages. You might need to be creative with some of the projects in putting them together in a way that works for you, e.g. the elephant trunk. I also used glue dots instead of the recommended tape or glue and I think it works out a lot better.
