I am an avid fan of Paper Crafts magazines and other books that they have published. I was more than excited when my local bookstore had it in stock and on sale w/a coupon. They have always had tons of wonderful ideas, and lots of things to go on.....PRO: It does motivate one to bring out their stash and work on paper supplies, and it gives one great ideas to make invites/thank you cards/decor, etc. Lots of pictures to give tons of motivation.CONNS: Unfortunately, my hopes were shattered when I looked through the book and saw great ideas! They fail to list their supplies and the respective companies associated with it (like in their magazines). Another total fail is, "Designer Tip: Font used in

these projects found on included CD." (p137). Bull. I open the disk and it's just 2 pre-made templates with that font used. It is NOT a .ttf file or of the like, it does not give you the font. Another annoying point is on p94/95. There is an oven for a baby shower and it states, "Using template found on CD, make oven from patterned paper, assemble." This is slightly inaccurate. I open the CD and click on what is to be the file and it's actually a .pdf from Papertrey Ink, and the link provided on that .pdf links to an unavailable website. If you need great party ideas it's a good go-to book, but if you want further information on what they used, you will have to do your own research or most scrapbookers/stampers can 9/10x figure it out. Don't get it for the CD (I thought it was a great bonus at the time) get it for the ideas. 11 of 12 people found the following review helpful. This book is a joke! Only 43 out of 1000 projects have template included. I feel be cheated!! By Vimal Earnest Okay I bought this book because my boy's birthday is coming. Since there was no other review, my decision was solely based on the pretty cover. As we all know judging a book by its cover is not a good idea, so 's description about this book comes with a CD confirmed my decision. I thought a CD-Rom means all the projects in the books will have detail description + templates for readers to use. I got this book about 4 days ago. This book does contain about 1000 projects. There are about 130 party themes (although a lot of them are similar) and each one of them contains 5-8 projects. Although most of the projects are similar (napkin rings, banners, invitation cards etc.), but still looking at the pretty photos inside the book did encourage me a nice birthday party for my son. So I finally broke the CD-Rom paper case today and only found out how lame the content is. CD-Rom contains 3 folders, Supply_lists, Patterns, and Digital_Downloads (fonts etc). You can probably guess what they are by looking at the folder names. However, the trick is, not every project is included. Out of the 130 party themes and 1000 projects as the author claims, there is only 43 files in Patterns (a.k.a. templates) folder. And each file only has 1 pattern!! In other words, out of the 1000 project author claims, THERE IS ONLY 43 TEMPLATES INCLUDED IN THE CD-ROM!!! That is less than 5%!!! As you can see from book preview, page 53, there is a showcase for single cupcake stand. I was expecting a template for the stand given the description from this book saying "Print templates on cardstock; trim....". I looked high and low from the CD-Rom all I can find is the project on page 52 is skipped. There is no template at all!! Only lame description tells you how to die cut a template and assemble it. WTF!? What template? What is the difference buying this book than just looking up pretty photos from internet? I even looked up their website hoping to see whatever I have missed. But no, nothing there either. I feel be cheated by author.
