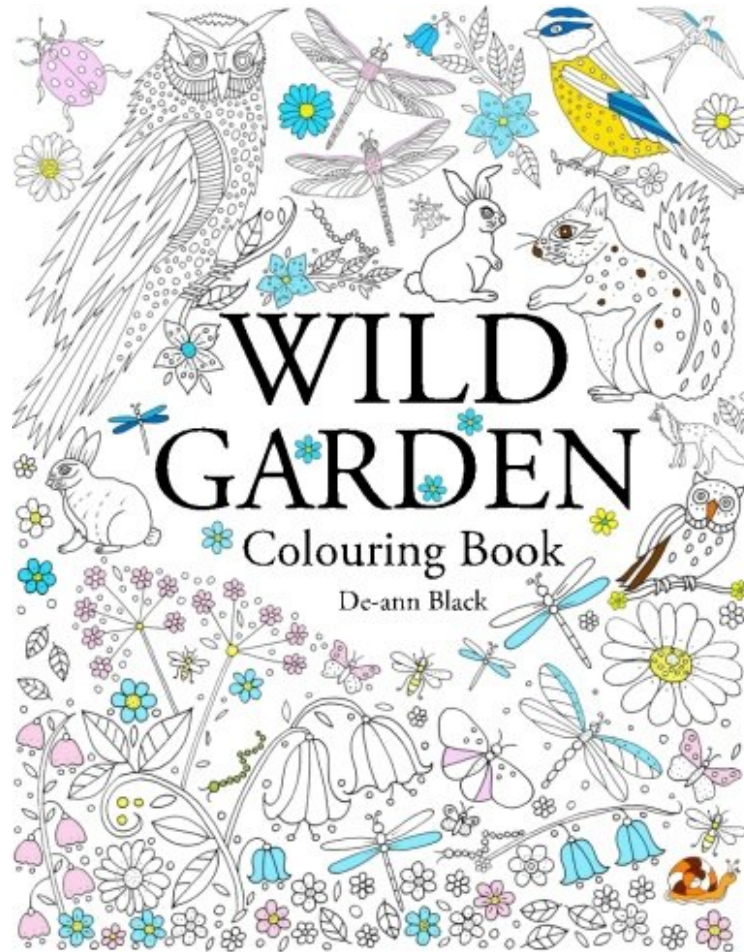

Some are more detailed than others, some are mandalas, all are very cute and can be colored realistically or fancifully. They are not in the same category as Johanna Basford's illustrations (I love her work) but they're very nice for times when I want to color something that's "easier" and faster. I just ordered several more in the "Garden" series to have on hand, since I like to swap around with various themes and styles in my coloring books. The paper quality is good with colored pencils, I don't know about gel-pens, etc., since I don't use those. The pictures are on only one side of the paper, which is always a good feature when coloring--even with pencils. Gets most things rightBy Rainbow ColoursThis was one of the first books that I had bought from this author and although it did have areas for improvement, it was a book that I enjoyed using and I don't regret buying it.It was slightly shorter than A4 in length but had the same width and I would say that the overall quality of the 2 covers and paper was good at best. The covers were thinner than your average art colouring book but had a really nice soft feel to it. The inner pages were average thickness.What I always enjoy with art books is to flick through the book before I use it and from the 30 pages inside, each design was on the front page (not on the back as well thankfully!) and that will be important to users who use media that might bleed through.The designs were appealing and appropriate in general and it had a good mix of animals, insects and plants with a few examples being butterfly's, squirrels, acorns, dandelions, buttercups, leafs, snails, owls, ladybirds, rabbits, foxes, deers, hedgehogs and a tiger as a special bonus!.In use, I found that it had a really good mix of detailed to wider area designs and many were geometric patterns. I used a number of different colouring mediums on the book and sadly, whilst colouring pencils didn't colour that well on the paper (not vibrant enough), gel pens and fine line pens could colour very well on it but did smudge a little bit.In terms of what I disliked and liked about the book: I disliked how the print quality (the lines) were not as crisp as I would have liked, the structure and layout of certain circular designs seemed to be a bit repetitive, although the inner contents were different and finally how the paper was not perforated.I liked the subject matter in general, it had a good selection of animals and plants, how some of the animals had been integrated within some of the patterns and more importantly how it had a really good balance of detailed and wider area designs.

Wild Garden is a colouring book by author and artist De-ann Black. The book contains 30 of her original illustrations, patterns and designs, hand drawn in pen and ink. The flower and nature theme of this colouring book is based on several of her books. The pictures are printed on one side of each page.
