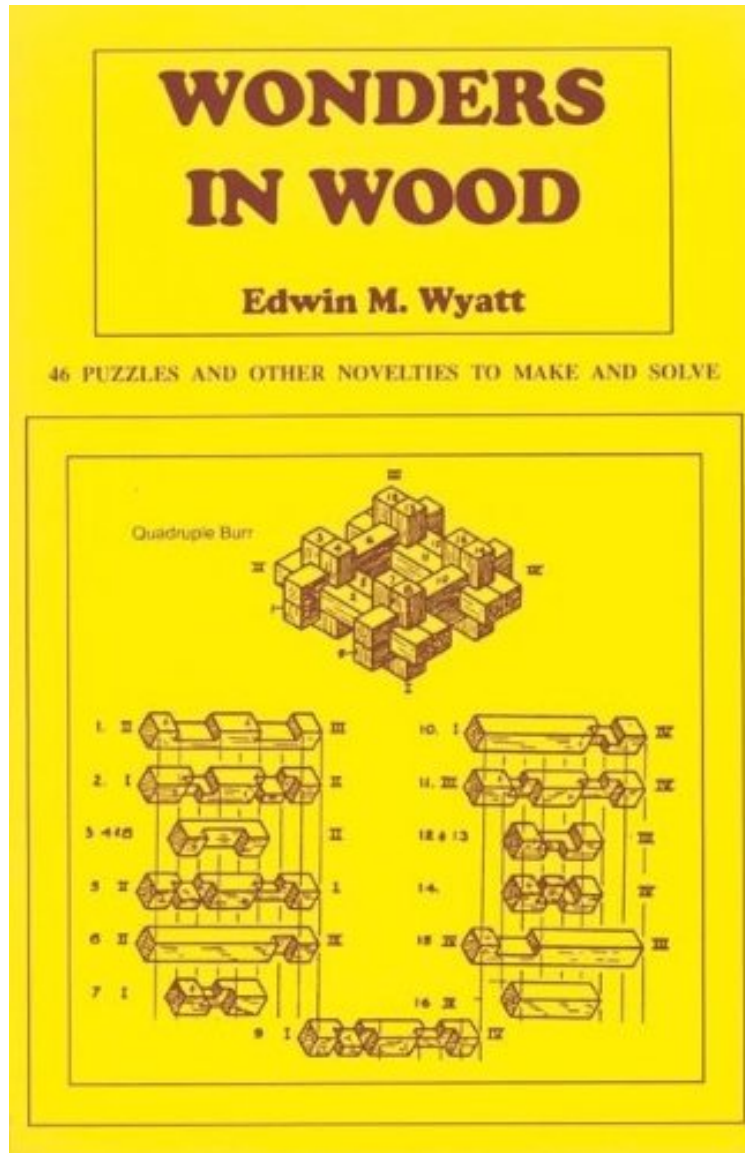

This is the sequel to the author's hugely popular ""Puzzles in Wood"" which was reprinted by popular demand and which has been selling for over fifty years. In this collection some 46 puzzles are just waiting to be made up and solved. They range from the simple to quite challenging pieces for those craftsmen who like to take pride in having their work fit snugly and accurately. A nest of thirteen pieces of dollhouse furniture, bandsawn from a rectangular block of wood, makes a striking demonstration of what can be done on a bandsaw or fretsaw. And the three dimension jigsaw puzzle makes a great variation on the conventional jigsaw. Try squaring triangles or making a triple dovetail puzzle, or the eighteen piece double-cross. And when you've finished these beauties go for the Marbles in a Maze! Happy puzzling!
