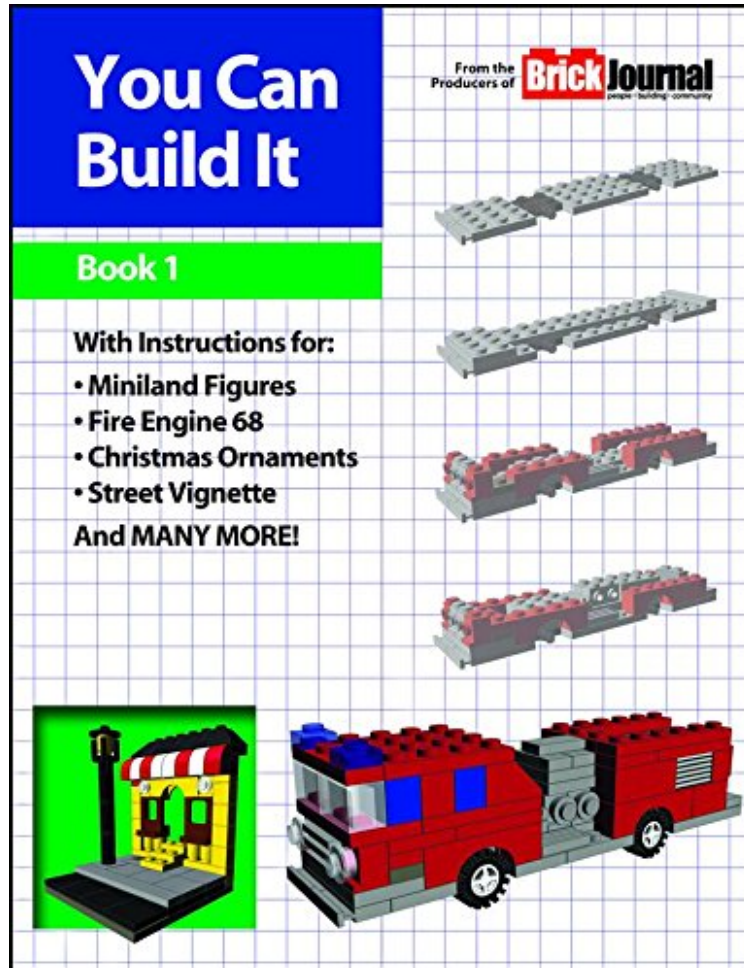

I decided to get him a "creative" set along with the other detailed, "must build exactly as instructed" sets. He loves those for sure, and then he loves to build something new and mix up his airplane with his fire truck and never have either one again! I saw this book, and some reviews, and went with this as a way to inspire him to follow some different directions or create his own! The majority of his Lego bricks are sorted by color into a 39 drawer container. I thought this would be perfect! After two frustrating attempts, the book sits unused. The instructions are clear, the ideas are good! But I have a child with thousands of sorted pieces from numerous types of sets, that had maybe 25% of the blocks called for in a given project. It was disappointing to say the least.I would not recommend this to anyone unless you're committed to buying numerous individual bricks and you have a child willing

to wait for delivery. If you're an adult builder and interested, the projects seem a little lacking in difficulty, but maybe a good project if you order the pieces ahead of time and build with a child. But it seems a little complicated considering the ease of numerous other sets! It is certainly a good idea, I love the concept of taking what you have and making something new! Perhaps a book that has a group of projects intentionally created with pieces from certain like-styled sets. All from Lego City, or Lego Star Wars, for example, while letting consumers know, "projects were made from pieces found in sets numbered 'xxxx' or 'xxxx'". I did assume they would be more readily available pieces that we could find in another color if not the one listed. I was wrong about that, at least for our collection. Just be prepared to buy the individual bricks, and be sure to have an especially organized system to find the right pieces in a timely manner! 2 of 2 people found the following review helpful.
