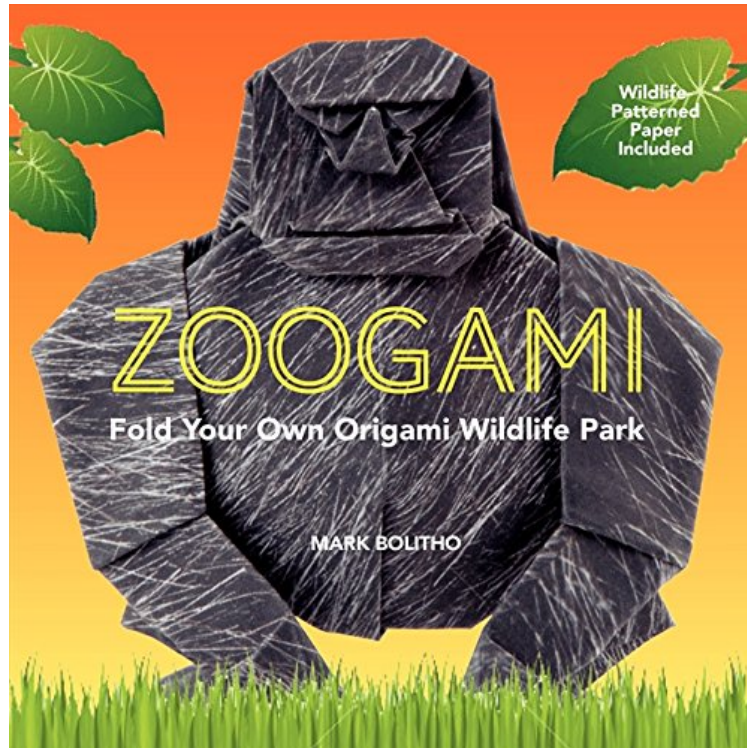

By Paul Critelli I was quite eager to see this and glad that Mr. Bolitho was to share some of his great creations with us, but I have had a good deal of trouble following the diagrams and instructions. Most books' cover hype is just that, and I can accept that - but the diagrams and instructions are far from "clear," and the "step-by-step" seems to leave a good deal to the trial and error and error and error and frustrating error department. As with many origami books, the first few diagrams of any model assume zero knowledge of what the simplest fold is, but then, usually by step 6 or 7, the folds are poorly described and even more poorly diagrammed. I would consider myself an intermediate folder - mainly self-taught and often frustrated by the "intermediate" works of other origami legends - with notable exceptions such as Neale and Robinson and The Biddles to name a few. The present book is not for the beginner at all, in my opinion, and the journeymen of the art would benefit GREATLY from larger and more clearly defined diagrams (I suspect there MAY be some errors in some of these - I could well be mistaken). Why don't these generous and creative artists who do decide to share their work - and I, for one, am totally grateful for their consideration and generosity - follow the simple but completely needed device that artists such as LaFosse and some others offer: include a DVD! No, origami is not an "easy-as-pie" craft or hobby - and "working with the paper" is a good thing. But, even with a teaching DVD, the person has to DO the folding - but with a DVD, the people who fall into my skill and experience range (and those with lesser degrees of both) will have much more of a chance to celebrate the genius of creative legends such as Mark Bolitho.
